**Re: Determination Request/Multi Protocol Labeling System (MPLS)
/C&W/CJFS Cable System**


This is further to the Determination Request filed by TeleCayman Limited (TeleCayman) 11 July 2006 in respect of the above referenced matter.

TeleCayman received from Cable & Wireless, on July 17th, new CJFS Cable System pricing which is approximately 85% less than the pricing it received for "equivalent" capacity in responding to the AS&H and Maples and Calder bids. For the bids in question TeleCayman received a quote for an E 1 of approximately \$12,000. The C&W quote received by TeleCayman on July 17th prices a DS 3 circuit (i.e. 21 E1 circuits) at \$12,145 (copy attached).

TeleCayman is extremely concerned that such pricing should issue approximately one week after its Determination Request was filed and various comments made on the issue in the press. If C&W utilized the pricing now being made available to TeleCayman in responding to the bids in question (which was 85% higher than what C&W quoted to TeleCayman) it has breached subsection 36 (2) (d) of the Information and Communications Technology Authority Law (2004 Revision) (the Law) by applying dissimilar pricing conditions to equivalent transactions thereby placing TeleCayman at a competitive disadvantage. As C&W uniquely controls' pricing on the CJFS Cable System it is in a dominant position in this regard and any dissimilar pricing would constitute an abuse of a dominant position in a market contrary to section 40 of the Law. Additionally, if the pricing provided to TeleCayman for the E 1 circuits on the CJFS Cable System were not 20% less than provided for in the bids then C&W is in serious breach of Part 5 of its Licence and the regulatory regime negotiated with the Government of the Cayman Islands and the Authority.

TeleCayman respectfully submits that it is incumbent upon the Authority to conduct an investigation in accordance with section 41 of the Law as there are reasonable grounds for suspecting that the section 36 (and section 40) prohibition has been infringed. If C&W has indeed engaged in anti-competitive pricing on the CJFS Cable System it has significantly prevented competition on all large customer accounts which need redundancy off Island as part of their overall requirements. TeleCayman is equally concerned that C&W pricing for these bids, if the new CJFS Cable System pricing was utilized, would likely not pass imputation tests overall.
