Re: Broadcast Signal Lab Report on the State of FM Broadcasting in Grand Cayman

With reference to a letter dated 11 July 2008, which appeared over your signature and being addressed to Mr. Stephan Faucette of Christian Communication Association (“CAA”) and Mr. Don Seymour of dms Broadcasting Ltd.
