Re: Indirect Access for Public Pay Phones – Proposed Phase One Implementation

Dear Philip;

TeleCayman would like to draw your attention to the subject of long distance usage and access via public pay phones in Grand Cayman. As we are all aware, large numbers of visitors arrive in Grand Cayman every day and these tourists or business travelers have communications needs, (typically long distance services) that are not carrier specific. Pay phone users at the Cruise Ship terminal and throughout Cayman are not subscribers to any specific network or Carrier and therefore should have a choice of and access to any licenced provider for long distance call completion. TeleCayman is requesting that the Information and Communication Technology Authority make all pay phones available for Indirect Access and long distance call completion by any Licenced Carrier.

TeleCayman believes that this would be an excellent first phase for Indirect Access and would result in immediate benefits to consumers through improved prices and services. Also, this action could assist in facilitating the development of an increasingly competitive marketplace. We believe the implementation of this recommendation is significant in the promotion of choice and reducing the distinct advantage of the Incumbent Carrier. We would appreciate hearing your viewpoint on this subject and would be available for discussion at your convenience.
