Re: Report of the LNP Consortium


The members of the LNP Consortium have directed me to report to the Authority on the status of the activities of the LNP Consortium. This report is without prejudice to the rights of individual members of the LNP Consortium to submit to the Authority their views on the proceedings of the LNP Consortium, where they may differ from mine.

On 7 May 2010, the Consortium issued RFP documents to six parties. The documents included the RFP document itself, an indicative contract for central reference database and order handling services, and a draft set of business rules. For reasons of confidentiality, the parties are listed in the attachment to this letter, and the Consortium requests that the Authority treat it in confidence. Disclosure of the identities of prospective vendors, particularly at this stage of the process, could jeopardize their involvement in the process, which would be to the detriment of the Consortium.

With respect to the Draft Business Rules, Digicel submitted their comments on the document yesterday, and the Business Process Committee will be reviewing them shortly.

We would be pleased to answer any questions the Authority may have.
